 - **UPLOAD** the following documents into the “manage documents” folder in Final Forms:
 - **Child's Birth Certificate**
 - **Immunization Record** - Immunization Waivers are **ONLY** available through the [Allegan County Health Department](#)
 - **Proof of Residency**
 1. A driver's license or state identification card showing the parent or guardian's name and address within the District **AND**
 2. The appropriate documentation as follows:
 - a. For the homeowner: a warranty deed to the property, a closing statement (dated within 2 months of the date of enrollment), a current property tax bill, or a mortgage payment statement.
 - b. For a renter: a signed current lease, a landlord affidavit using the district form
 - 3. **Any two of the following** (showing name of parent/guardian and address within the district):
 - a. gas/electric bill
 - b. telephone or cellular phone bill
 - c. cable or satellite TV bill
 - d. renter's or homeowner's insurance policy
 - e. bank or credit card statement
 - f. current automobile registration, current automobile insurance policy or statement
 - [School of Choice Application](#) (if applicable) - if you are not a resident of the Hopkins Public School District
 - [Free/Reduced Lunch Applications](#) must be completed after July 1 to be valid for the upcoming school year.
 - **Medication Forms** (*Please print ONLY if needed and turn in to the school office*):
